



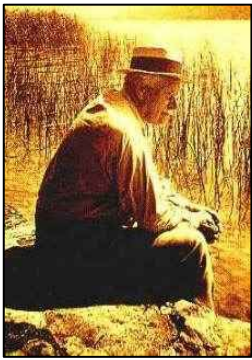

From New Age groups to programs for training classical spiritual directors, Jung's thought has been an indispensable - and provocative - tool for those who take seriously the spiritual journey. This is the first of what we hope will become an ongoing annual seminar exploring seminal Jungian texts that illumine the journey.

We'll begin with *Memories, Dreams, Reflections*, Jung's "spiritual autobiography," and continue with *The Red Book*, the large, illuminated personal volume in which Jung recorded fruits of his legendary "confrontation with the unconscious" that occurred following his break with Freud. *The Red Book*, created between 1914 and 1930, and previously unpublished, is being published in October 2009.

In future years, we'll explore additional primary texts of Jung himself, and also consider some of the fine secondary studies penned by post-Jungians. This seminar will be of interest to clinicians, spiritual directors, and religious leaders. The presenter also invites the participation of "non-professionals" of diverse spiritual interests and backgrounds.
